The Canadian Workplace Wellness Pioneer Award was initiated by the Health Work & Wellness™ Conference in 1997 to recognize the outstanding achievements of one individual who has made a pioneering, impactful, and sustainable contribution in the field of organizational health and well-being.

Pioneer award nominees will have demonstrated excellence and made a sustainable contribution to organizational health in a number of ways, such as through research; the development and implementation of a successful organizational health model, strategy or tool; advocacy, or by otherwise distinguishing themselves in the workplace health field. The nomination and adjudication process is managed by the Pioneer Award Review Committee and is presented annually at the Health Work & Wellness™ Conference.

This award acknowledges an individual's work in the field of Workplace Health and Wellness in Canada. This individual has exceeded the normal expectations in their field by making a significant and sustainable difference to workplace well-being either at the workplace, community, provincial or national level. Through his/her work, the award winner has creatively inspired others of the value of organizational health and well-being.

Do you know a colleague who has excelled in this way? Why not give them the recognition they deserve?

Each submission will be rated against the criteria in the following 5 categories:

- 1. Research** (3 points)
- 2. Development of a workplace tool, program, and/or strategy** (3 points)
- 3. Advocacy for workplace wellness/organizational health** (4 points)
- 4. Long-term impact and sustainability of contribution** (2 points)
- 5. Personal values and approach to workplace wellness** (3 points)

The Workplace Wellness Award Review Committee has developed specific criteria for the purpose of judging the nominations. Award Submission Checklist:

Please submit the nomination via email in one complete submission. Only fully completed submissions will be accepted.

- Complete the nomination form below.
- Describe in 250 words this person's achievements **relative to the criteria of the five categories described fully at www.healthworkandwellness.com on the Awards Page**. How has this individual made an outstanding, sustainable contribution to workplace health and well-being in Canada?
- Include at least two letters of recommendation for the nominee that describe specifically how the person has made a significant and pioneering, impactful, and sustainable contribution to the field of Workplace Health and Wellness, using the award criteria which can be found on the Health Work & Wellness™ Conference website. - Include appropriate supportive articles, and/or documentation developed by the nominee or written about or by the nominee that supports the five categories. Maximum of 2- 3 pages each. If a research paper or journal article is submitted which is longer, please include ONLY the executive summary. No video or audio clips or YouTube entries and no PPT presentations please.
- Include a resume of the nominee that covers all relevant information for the purpose of the award (3 pages maximum).
